

FINANCIAL POLICIES

1. TUITION Schedule: Grades Nursery - 8

The school’s expectation at the time of registration is that all tuition and fees will be paid on time. Failure to do so serves, to rupture the contract that we make with parents and this could result in the suspension of a child for delinquent tuition or fees.

- Parishioners parents and children who are registered members of St. Lucy’s parish, attend Sunday Mass, and contribute to the support of the parish.
- Out-of-Parish families who attend Mass regularly in a parish other than St. Lucy’s parish, and who contribute to the support of that parish, as confirmed by a letter from their pastor.
- Non-Catholic families other than Catholic.

2. TUITION DELINQUENCY

Families who are 30 days late on tuition will receive notification letters from SMART tuition. Families who are delinquent 60 days on tuition will receive a second letter; this letter will come from the Principal. Upon receipt of this notification, parents/guardians are asked to contact the Principal to discuss a tuition payment plan. If a parent/guardian does not contact the Principal within two weeks of receiving the letter, the child/children may not be permitted to attend school.

3. FEES

All fees should be paid on time. If there are outstanding fees at the time of report card distribution, the report card will be withheld until fees are paid. Problems or difficulties involving finances must be taken up with the Pastor. Please contact him at the rectory.

IMPORTANT: In order for a family to qualify for the parishioner’s tuition rate, parents must contribute a minimum of \$ 7.00 in each Sunday envelope. In November, there will be a review of the Mass attendance and contributions of all parishioner families.

Families who have not been attending Mass and who have not contributed \$7.00 each Sunday will no longer be eligible for the parishioner rate and will be assigned a new tuition rate for non-participating families.

Your participation in ongoing religious, educational, and voluntary programs of our school is vital to our school and to our children. We thank you for your cooperation and support you give to St. Lucy's School.

4. FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

Tuition and fees do not cover all expenses for educating your child in our school. Therefore, it is necessary for us to conduct several fund-raising activities throughout the school year.

Parents are obligated under the terms of the school's finance policy to participate in two events during the school year. Please consult the fund raising information letter sent home with the summer mailing for details and options. Your cooperation insures the continuation of the excellent programs offered at St. Lucy's.

The financial sacrifices of the parents and parishioners who donate time and money to our school demand our gratitude and appreciation. Parents can best show this by their full and timely cooperation with the financial policies of the school.

Each family is required to participate in 2 mandated fund raisers each year. A TOTAL of \$300 in sales is required of each family every school year or if \$150 is paid by October 1st, fundraising is complete.
