

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

The school uniform, including school shoes, must be worn from the first day of school in September until the last day of school in June, except in special circumstances set by the Administration.

The **SCHOOL UNIFORM** consists of the following:

GIRLS — GRADES K TO 8:

Grey skirt

White knit shirt w/embroidery (short or long sleeve available)

8th graders: Blue knit shirt w/embroidery

Grey socks/knee highs/tights

Black school shoe

Navy School vest

K-4 School shoes must be black-laced or Velcro- **NO SLIP-ONS**

5-8 – School shoes can be black slip-ons but **NO BALLERINA SLIPPERS**

Navy blue school sweater (cardigan/ pullover - optional)

BOYS — GRADES K TO 8:

Navy SLS slacks with **BELT**

White knit shirt w/embroidery (short or long sleeve available)

8th graders: Blue knit shirt w/embroidery

Navy School vest

Black socks

Black school shoe

Navy blue school sweater (cardigan/pullover - optional)

VESTS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL GRADES

OPTIONAL SUMMER UNIFORM consists of the following: (May be worn from the opening of school through October 15th and again from May 1st to the end of school).

BOYS AND GIRLS — GRADES K TO 8:

Navy walking shorts

Belt

White knit shirt with school logo embroidery

8th graders: Blue knit shirt w/embroidery

(boys may wear this shirt with regular uniform pants and shoes).

ALL WHITE SNEAKERS for girls*****

ALL BLACK SNEAKERS for boys***

*******BELTS ARE TO BE WORN EVERYDAY AND SHIRTS ARE TO BE TUCKED IN AT ALL TIMES.**

The **GYM UNIFORM** consists of the following:

BOYS AND GIRLS — ALL GRADES

Grey school sweat pants and shirt with school logo
Grey school T shirt & navy shorts with insignia (warm days)
Sneakers- **SAME AS REGULAR SCHOOL UNIFORM**
White socks

It is mandatory to wear the T-shirt; sweatshirt may be worn if desired.

N.B. The gym uniform must be worn in place of the school uniform on gym days.

No student will be allowed to participate in the program without the proper gym uniform.

NOTE: THE SUMMER UNIFORM MAY NOT TAKE THE PLACE OF THE GYM UNIFORM.

8TH GRADE STUDENTS MUST WEAR A BLUE UNIFORM POLO SHIRT.

**NURSERY, PRE-K: Velcro sneakers- ALL WHITE SNEAKERS FOR THE GIRLS
ALL BLACK SNEAKERS FOR THE BOYS**

No colors, no lights, no design of any kind.

Additional guidelines pertaining to the school uniform dress code are as follows:

- No make-up may be worn; (NO LIP-GLOSS) only clear nail polish is allowed; no nail tips
- Excessive jewelry is inappropriate with a school uniform and is, therefore, not permitted.

A watch (black, brown, metal) and a small religious medal are allowed. Only girls are permitted to wear **ONE** small button earrings (**no color**) in the ear lobe. No earring is permitted in any other part of the ear. No dangling, hoop earrings or name earrings are to be worn. Boys may not wear any earrings. Bracelets are not allowed. No chains, necklaces, nameplates, chokers or rosary beads may be worn; one religious medal is permitted on a chain to be worn under the shirt/blouse. Only one ring is permitted.

• Hair is to be kept, short, clean and well groomed. For boys and girls, **no FAD or DESIGN haircuts, styles or UNATURAL HAIR COLOR are allowed.** No dyed or streaked hair is permitted. For girls, any **SMALL hair ribbons, bows, combs, beads and headbands must be blue, black, gray or white. No other colors are allowed.**

- No Facial hair is allowed on boys;
- No pins or buttons may be worn on the school uniform;
- If T-shirts are worn under shirts/blouses they must be plain white. NO PRINT, LETTERING, or DESIGNS may be on them.

ONLY THE SCHOOL UNIFORM SWEATER MAY BE WORN DURING SCHOOL HOURS.

ALL UNIFORMS MUST BE PURCHASED DIRECTLY THROUGH THE SCHOOL

DEMERITS WILL BE ISSUED FOR ANY UNIFORM INFRACTION (SEE DISCIPLINARY POLICY)

DRESS DOWN DAY/DANCE CODE:

GIRLS MAY NOT WEAR BIG EARRINGS (HOOPS...DANGLING)

NO STUDENT IS PERMITTED TO WEAR TANK TOPS

IF SHORTS ARE WORN THEY MAY NOT BE ABOVE THE KNEE

Grades 1-8: NO SKIRTS OR DRESSES ARE ALLOWED

PANTS MUST BE FITTED AT THE WAIST AND CROTCH

NO LEGGINGS

NO BARE MIDRIFTS OR TANK TOPS

NO SHORT SHORTS – SHORTS MUST BE KNEE LENGTH

NO PAJAMA PANTS OR RIPPED JEANS

CONSEQUENCES RANGE FROM PARENTS BEING CALLED TO BRING A CHANGE OF CLOTHING, AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION OR SUSPENSION.
